Case Study: Deadly Nitrogen Leak at Food Manufacturer

In December 2020, a food manufacturer in Vernon, CA, experienced a hazardous gas leak of nitrogen which tragically resulted in the death of 2 employees. The employer recently plead guilty to criminal charges related to the incident and was ordered to pay a \$1 million criminal fine and \$35 million civil settlement with the victims' families. The Cal/OSHA investigation revealed significant deficiencies in the facility's safety procedures and training related to the pressurized gas systems. This case serves as a sobering reminder of the real-world consequences of inadequate safety management.

Robust safety management saves lives; simple practices can have significant impacts. Here are practical actions to take at your workplace today:

- Conduct comprehensive hazard assessments. Regularly evaluate all workplace processes and equipment to identify potential hazards.
- Ensure employees are thoroughly trained. All training should include verification that key concepts are understood and applied correctly.
- Establish and enforce clear safety protocols. These protocols should be written down and accessible to employees.
- Encourage a culture of safety communication. Empower employees to report unsafe conditions and take prompt corrective action.
- Audit and review safety programs regularly. Programs should be not only compliant but also effective.
