Hazard Awareness: Heat Illness

As we enter the peak of summer, it's important to ensure of your workplace's Heat Illness Prevention Program is being implemented properly. Cal-OSHA requires employers to manage risks associated with both indoor and outdoor heat.

Key elements of Heat Illness Prevention Programs:

- Access to clean and cool water
- Access to cool-down areas (indoors) or shade (outdoors)
- High-heat procedures (outdoors)
- Emergency response procedures, including how to respond to signs and symptoms of heat illness
- Monitoring new employees during acclimatization
- Training for employees

Awareness can be a key part of preventing heat illness in employees. Ensure that workers know the signs of heat illness and are empowered to take quick action to prevent it. Stay cool!
